THE GODLY LIFE

What does a godly life look like? We find a guide in 1 Timothy 3, where the Apostle Paul describes the qualities of an overseer or elder of the church. To be considered godly, one must be:

above reproach faithful temperate self-controlled respectable hospitable able to teach not given to drunkenness not violent but gentle not quarrelsome not a lover of money



Rather than view this as a checklist for admission to the "godly life club," consider the importance of helping believers develop these traits. Supporting each believer in their desire to incorporate these characteristics into his or

her life is our responsibility. This is called discipleship and it is an important component in the life of a believer in Jesus Christ. It is also something that Wooddale Church sees as a priority.

Once you begin a relationship with Jesus Christ, you grow stronger in that relationship by learning more about what it means to be a follower of Jesus. There are various ways to learn and grow – Bible studies and fellowship with other believers to name a couple. At Wooddale, there are also men and women who meet one-on-one with another Christ-follower to mentor him or her in their spiritual walk.

If you are a new follower of Jesus Christ, we encourage you to seek out opportunities to be discipled at Wooddale through LifeGroups or One-to-One Mentoring. MEN'S FALL BIBLE STUDIES

The path to spiritual maturity includes participating in opportunities to grow in your faith. Wooddale's men's ministry theme is "Get in the Game," an encouragement for men to be proactive in connecting, learning and growing, serving, and engaging with others in outreach. This fall, men have several such opportunities in the form of men's Bible studies and life-changing topical studies.

The Saturday morning men's Bible study will focus this fall on the Gospel of Luke. Men will learn practical life lessons from the life and ministry of Jesus as recorded by Luke, a physician with a unique look at the Gospel through the eyes of a scientist/physician.

This study begins Saturday, September 19 at 8 a.m. with a continental breakfast. The format for the study includes breaking into study groups at 8:30 a.m., followed by a concluding teaching "Wrap" presented by Adults Pastor Fred McCormick. The cost is \$20 per person for the fall to cover cost of breakfast and materials. Men of all ages/ stages are welcome.

Two additional growth opportunities for men this fall are the Wednesday morning and evening programs called "Stepping-Up." Both programs focus on growing in relationship with God, learning to become godly leaders at home, work, community and church, growing as godly husbands and fathers and managing our God-given resources wisely.

The Wednesday morning Stepping-Up group meets from 6:30-7:45 a.m. in Room 274 and offers two options for study/discussion: 1). Bible study in "The Gospel of Luke," and 2). Topical study series called "Authentic Manhood" written by Robert Lewis.

The Wednesday evening Stepping-Up group meets from 6:30-8 p.m. in Room 274, concurrently with Children's and Student Ministries programs. This group will also use Robert Lewis's "Authentic Manhood" series encouraging spiritual growth.

Both the morning and evening Wednesday groups begin September 16. The fee for each Wednesday fall study group is \$15 for printed materials and coffee. Both studies will continue in the winter/spring with separate registration required.

ture that was completely new to me. We had an amazing experience and learned much. The following summer, my dad and I returned to


