Summary

In 2022, let us slow down and notice the needs of people God has put in your life.

Scripture

Your kindness will reward you, but your cruelty will destroy you. -Proverbs 11:17 (NLT)

“Do to others whatever you would like them to do to you. This is the essence of all that is taught in the law and the prophets. -Matthew 7:12 (NLT)

Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. -Romans 12:15 (ESV)

Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ. -Galatians 6:2 (NLT)

See that no one pays back evil for evil, but always try to do good to each other and to all people. -1 Thessalonians 5:15 (NLT)

Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. -Colossians 3:12 (NLT)

Let your gentle *spirit* be known to all men. The Lord is near. -Philippians 4:5 (NASB)

Don't be concerned for your own good but for the good of others. -1 Corinthians 10:24 (NLT)

And do everything with love. -1 Corinthians 16:14 (NLT)
