## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

### The Clarity March 1, 2026

#### Summary

In *Unwavering: The Clarity* (Habakkuk 2:2–5), the sermon explores how God brings clarity in the midst of confusion. Like a diver descending into murky waters, unsure of what lies ahead, we often ask, “Do we keep going?” Habakkuk felt the same tension as he wrestled with God’s plan to use Babylon for judgment. God’s response begins with, “Write this down,” a reminder that His revelation is certain, public and trustworthy.

From Habakkuk 2:3, we learn four anchors of clarity: God owns all time, God has a plan, God’s plan is true and we are called to wait for it. Though fulfillment may seem delayed, God’s purposes are appointed and will not fail. The choice, then, is clear: live by feelings or live by faith.

Just as a diver clings to a descent line in dark waters, we cling to God’s Word. We say yes to Jesus, refuse to walk alone and anchor ourselves in the story of God’s faithfulness, trusting Him through life’s swirl.

#### Scripture

Then the LORD replied:

“Write down the revelation  
and make it plain on tablets  
so that a herald may run with it.  
For the revelation awaits an appointed time;  
it speaks of the end  
and will not prove false.  
Though it lingers, wait for it;  
it will certainly come  
and will not delay.  
“See, the enemy is puffed up;  
his desires are not upright—  
but the righteous person will live by his faithfulness—  
indeed, wine betrays him;  
he is arrogant and never at rest.  
Because he is as greedy as the grave  
and like death is never satisfied,  
he gathers to himself all the nations  
and takes captive all the peoples.  
Habakkuk 2:2-4 (NIV)

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For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes: first to the Jew, then to the Gentile. For in the gospel the righteousness of God is revealed—a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: “The righteous will live by faith.” Romans 1:16-17 (NIV)

3. The sermon mentioned four truths: God owns all time, God has a plan, God's plan is true and we are to wait. Which of these is hardest for you to believe when life feels chaotic? Why?
4. Are feelings and faith oppositional to one another? Explain your thought process.
5. What does it practically mean to live by faith instead of by feelings?
6. What would it look like for you to hold onto the line of God's Word in that situation? By choosing to be a part of this Life Group, you've chosen to commit to life-changing relationships. How can we partner with you as you seek to cling to the truth of God's Word in this season?

### Let's Act

When God gives you clarity through His Word, take a moment to write it down and intentionally hold onto His word in faith.

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
