Easter: Looking for Life April 20, 2025

Summary

In this Easter message, Pastor Kyle reflects on the search for meaning, purpose and true life—often in the wrong places. Drawing from Luke 24:1-8, he reminds us that just as the women at the tomb looked for Jesus among the dead, we too often look for life where it cannot be found. Jesus' resurrection is presented as the historical and spiritual turning point that changes everything. Luke's account is shown to be historically credible and rooted in eyewitness testimony, and Jesus' death and resurrection are necessary for the forgiveness of sin and the gift of new, eternal life. Stop searching for life among things that are dead and instead respond to Jesus, the true source of life.

Scripture

On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. While they were wondering about this, suddenly two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning stood beside them. In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: 'The Son of Man must be delivered over to the hands of sinners, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.'" Then they remembered his words.

5. What does saying yes to Jesus look like in this season of your life? Is there something you sense God inviting you to surrender?
