Let's Review

- Sermon scriptures: [Jn 3:16] [Acts 2:42-44] [Rom 6:3, 12:5-10] [1 Cor 3:9, 12:13]
 [Gal 6:2, 12:10] [Eph 2:19, 4:16] [1 Tim 3:14-15] [Hb 10:25] [1 Pt 2:17, 4:9] [1 Jn 3:10-14, 4:20-21]
- Real fellowship means loving God's family (God's family = each other).
- Four levels of fellowship or belonging to God's family: Choosing to Belong, Learning to Share, Partnership, Kinship

Let's Dig

- What is fellowship? What is Church? And how are they connected?
- What is the vision that our Wooddale family has committed to?
- As a LifeGroup, how are you doing sharing life experiences, your homes, and your problems with one another? What can you do to improve?
- How do you, personally, serve and partner with God's family?
- Read Deuteronomy 22:1-4 and talk about partnering with/serving others.
 - a. Why would God include this in the law?
 - b. How does this affect the way we think about the problems of others?
- Read John 15:9-17 and talk about sacrificial "kinship."
 - c. Has anyone (besides Christ) ever shown you sacrificial love? Have you shown others sacrificial love?
 - d. What does it take for sacrificial love to go beyond being a nice idea, to actually being lived out?
- Read Psalm 42:1-4 and talk about being a part of God's family
 - e. Why is it important to be connected to God's family?
 - f. Do we take the presence of God's family around us for granted? If so, what can we do to change that?
 - g. How does this impact your thoughts of Christ followers isolated in hostile places?
