Sermon: OMTL – Learn Humbly

Scripture: Luke 14:11

Date: Jan. 30 & 31, 2016

—[LET'S TALK]—

- If there are new people in the group for OMTL, spend some time getting to know each other.
- What has been one of your proudest moments in life so far?

—[LET'S WARM UP]—

- What is humility? What does it look like to be truly humble?
- How have you seen our culture respond to humility? Try to give specific examples.
- How important is humility and why?
- Why do we need to humbly learn? What is the connection between learning/growth and humility?

—[LET'S DIG | CHOOSE 1]—

- Read 1 Thessalonians 5:12-23 and talk about being dependent on God.
 1. How many commands and exhortations do you find in this passage?
 2. Do people live this way? Why or why not.
 3. If people actually lived this way, what kind of world do these commands add up to?
 4. Having considered all these things, now read 5:24. What does this tell you?
- Read Luke 18:9-17 and talk about humility and salvation.
 1. What are the main differences between the Pharisee and the tax collector?
 2. Have you ever had thoughts like the Pharisee in this parable?
 3. Considering the context, what is the connection between children and the Kingdom?
 4. Can we be saved without true humility? Explain your answer.

—[LET'S ACT]—

- Pray for humility—but beware: God *always* says yes to this prayer.
- On a piece of paper, number from one to three on the left-hand side, and then do the same thing on the right-hand side. List three gifts, or strengths you know you possess on the left. Then on the right, list three growth areas you see in yourself. This week, ask three close friends or family members to give you a list three gifts and growth areas that they see in you. Compare the lists. What surprises you the most? Why?
