Series: Who is Jesus?

Scripture: Luke 9:18-36

Date: Jan 28 & 29, 2017

## —[ LET'S START ]—

- Take a few moments to see if there are any Adopt 7 stories in your group. Has anyone had an opportunity to serve anyone on their Adopt 7? Has anyone had an opportunity to share their faith with anyone on their Adopt 7?
- Have you ever had your opinion about a person change as you got to know them? What had been your first impression of them? As you became closer to that person what did you see that you didn't see before?

## —[ LET'S TALK ]—

1. Read Luke 9: 18-20 & Matthew 16:13-20. In this passage, Jesus first asks his disciples, "Who do the crowd say I am?" and then he asked them, "but what about you, who do you say I am?" How did Peter's response differ from that of the crowds? Why did the disciples have a different perspective on Jesus?
2. If Jesus were to ask you the question, "Who do you say I am?" how would you respond? Is there a time in your life when you would have responded differently to that question?
3. The Transfiguration of Jesus is described in Luke 9:28-36. Another significant mountaintop experience is described in Exodus 19 (verses 9, 16-24). What's the significance of the cloud that appeared on the mountain? What is different between these two mountaintop experiences?
4. In Luke 9:32, the disciples are sleeping through a significant experience. In the message, Pastor Dale mentioned that at times we can sleep through what God is doing around us. What are some ways that we can wake up spiritually?
5. In Luke 9:33, Peter provides an odd suggestion in response to what he is witnessing. Theologian N.T Wright states that Jesus doesn't belong in a tent alongside all of the other prophets. What makes Jesus so different from all the other prophets? What are ways that we try to put Jesus into a tent?
