Scripture: Luke 12:13-34

Date: March 4-5, 2017

—[LET'S START]—

- How busy were you last week? Did you have any moments like Mary when you were able to be still at the feet of Jesus?

—[LET'S TALK]—

1. Have someone read Luke 12:13-34 for the group. Jesus says that greed is a sin that we need to watch out for. What is it about greed that makes it more subtle than other sins?
2. Nobody ever thinks of him/herself as greedy. But greed doesn't care if you are rich or poor. It happens whenever we put our desire for something ahead of our desire for God. When is the last time you saw this in yourself?
3. Pastor Dale said you can know if you are struggling with greed by considering two things: (1) what satisfies you and (2) what worries you. What are some other ways you can know if you are putting things ahead of God in your life?
4. Read 2 Corinthians 8:8-9. As you think about the life of Jesus, what are some different ways He became poor for you? What are some of the ways His poverty made you rich?

—[LET'S ACT]—

- What is one way you can be less greedy and more generous this week?
- Take some time as a group to pray in thanks for the ways that Jesus became poor and you became rich. Commit to pray for each other in the coming week that your gratitude would motivate you toward generosity.
