

Day 1 - Depart USA for Berlin



Day 2

Berlin: Welcome to Germany! On arrival, a local guide will lead a tour of Berlin including stops at the famous Brandenburg Gate. Visit the Cathedral, the Reichstag building, the lively boulevards, and Cold War Check Point Charlie Museum.

Day 3

Berlin & Wittenberg: After a relaxed breakfast, visit Sanssouci Palace and Gardens in Potsdam, the summer residence of Frederick the Great and his retreat from the challenges of war and diplomacy. Sanssouci was built between 1745 and 1747, in an Italian rococo style. The gardens were created by Peter Joseph Lenné, Prussia's greatest landscape gardener. After arriving in Wittenberg mid-afternoon, join the Wittenberg English Ministry service, and worship with believers from all over the world.




Day 4

Wittenberg: Join a guided tour to the main sites connected with Martin Luther, including the Schlosskirche (Castle Church) where he nailed his famous 95 Theses to the door in 1517. Although the original door was destroyed in a fire, the replica has all 95 Theses in bronze. Then visit St. Mary's Church and tour the Lutherhalle (Luther House) Museum where Luther lived for 35 years. Here, he had his pivotal "Tower Experience" while reading Romans 1:17. The afternoon is at leisure.

Day 5

After breakfast, drive to Erfurt where Luther spent time as a monk. The guide will provide a walking tour including St. Mary's Cathedral where Luther was ordained, followed by a tour of the Augustinian Monastery and its Luther exhibition, including a typical cell from Luther's time. End the tour with a special service in the chapel. Tour guide will lead an optional evening walk to see the floodlit cathedral and lively cafes.



Day 6

Eisenach: Drive to nearby Eisenach and tour the Wartburg Castle. In 1521, while fleeing from the wrath of the Pope, Luther took refuge in the castle after a fake kidnapping staged by his friend and protector, Frederick the Wise. Tour the Wartburg and see where Luther finished translating the New Testament into German in just 11 weeks. Luther spent time in the nearby town of Eisenach as a school boy and sang in the choir of St. George's Church where the Bach family also worshiped. The afternoon is free to explore the town or tour the Bach Museum and Luther House Museum. Return to Erfurt at the end of the day. (Private Bach Concert in Bach Museum possible)

Day 7

Heidelberg: Drive to WORMS for a walking tour to see the Reformation Monument. It was here, during the Imperial Diet in 1521 that Martin Luther challenged the entire Roman Catholic establishment by his refusal to recant the great doctrines of Protestantism. Continue to Heidelberg for dinner and overnight. 1/2 day river cruise.



Day 8

Heidelberg: Enjoy Heidelberg, a gorgeous town on the Neckar River. The castle, once a royal residence, was the capital of the Rhineland palatinate. It was destroyed in 1671 and is now a fascinating ruin. During the Reformation the local rulers embraced Protestantism then turned to Calvinism and the Heidelberg Catechism was finalized here in 1563.




Day 9

Black Forest & Zurich: After a leisurely breakfast, drive through the scenic Black Forest region. Visit the Black Forest Open Air Museum to see impressive fully furnished Black Forest farm houses built from the 16th to the 9th century. Take time to walk around the museum and purchase regional delicacies in the on-site restaurant. In the afternoon, cross over into Switzerland for a night in Zurich.

Day 10

Zurich, Lucerne: Tour Zurich to learn about key reformers, Zwingli and the Anabaptists on a tour of the key Reformation. Tour the Grossmünster, the Helferei (where Zwingli lived) and see the Zwingli Statue. Other notable sites are the Fraumünster (the famous Catholic Cathedral) with its Marc Chagall windows. After a stroll through the historic Auld Stadt, have free time before continuing on to Lucerne (a picturesque lakeside setting against an impressive mountain backdrop and is often referred to as "the essence of Switzerland").



Day 11

Geneva: a short morning tour of city will include the 14th century Chapel Bridge, the most photographed monument in Switzerland. Mark Twain described the Lion Monument as "the most mournful and moving piece of stone in the world". Continue on to Geneva where Calvin, Knox, Farel, and others brought Christ's teachings to eager listeners. Begin tour at the impressive Reformation Monument. Four statues of the four Reformation leaders stand as sentinels to truth and courage inspired by godly faith. See Calvin's church, the Auditoire de Calvin, where the inspired theologian himself taught. Next door is St. Pierre's Cathedral, where John Calvin preached. See his chair and a restored section decorated as it would have been before Calvin's time. The final stop is an audio guide tour through the incredible Reformation Museum. Below the museum and the Cathedral, are the ruins of a Roman sanctuary, a 4th century basilica, and a 6th century church. Enjoy free time this afternoon to experience these key sites before a final dinner together.

Day 12

Transfer from hotel to airport for flight to US.

Trip Cancellation & Interruption
