—[ LET'S START ]—

Last week Pastor Dale concluded his message defining a disciple of Jesus as “a person who is actively following Jesus, is being changed by Jesus, and who is on mission with Jesus”. Discuss with a partner one of the ways you have been a disciple of Jesus during this last week.

—[ LET'S TALK ]—

1. The Bible reveals to us that Jesus discipled His followers through intentional relationships. Pastor Dale quoted pastor and author Jim Putman stating that, “Without true relationship, discipleship is not possible. More is caught than taught!” Who has been someone in your life that you have “caught” significantly from? What did you catch?
2. A real-life discipleship group is committed to: real teaching from God’s Word, being shepherded towards spiritual maturity, transparency, accountability, and reproducing what they have experienced when they are with others. Share examples of how this group has demonstrated each of these.
3. Pastor Dale has just started to identify for us the ***Stages of Spiritual Growth***. Think of someone (even one of your “Adopt 7” relationships) that may clearly be in a particular stage. Without naming names, can you describe why or how you can identify that person as being in that stage?
