Titus 2:12-14**

—[LET'S START]—

So far in this series, *At the Cross*, we have been shown that the cross transforms our lives and relationships. Christ's work on the cross provides us freedom, forgiveness, endurance, a healthy self-image and a joyful sense of belonging. This weekend's message is about "servanthood". Share with each other an example of where you may seek to be served. Then share examples of where you try to serve others. How do we look for personal value either way? Share your thoughts.

—[LET'S TALK]—

1. Have someone in the group read Mark 10:35-38 aloud. What do you suppose James and John were thinking? Why did Jesus say they didn't really know what they were asking? What are some similar examples that you see in today's world?
2. Reread Mark 10:45. What does the term "ransom" indicate and how does that relate to "self", "idols" and "law" as Pastor Dale explained in his message? Discuss Pastor Dale's statement, "...obey and serve Him out of His love for you, but not to earn His love for you!"
3. In John 13 is the account of Jesus washing the feet of the disciples, a task commonly done by a servant in those days. In verse 15, Jesus states He has set an example for them to follow. What are some of the ways you are able to serve others in the name of Jesus?
