## —[ LET'S START ]—

We have come to the end of our series on the meaning of intimacy. What has been your biggest takeaway from this series?

## —[ LET'S TALK ]—

1. In one of this week's questions, Pastor Dale was asked why we would look to Solomon as a role model when he was clearly so flawed. In his answer, Pastor Dale had us consider the context of Solomon's life. He was a man who started out right but ended badly. There are some powerful lessons that we can learn from him. Read Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 as a group. How does Solomon's final conclusion about life resonate with you? How have you seen this truth evident in your life?
2. Many of this week's questions had to do with things that society accepts as permissible that God says are wrong. Pastor Dale said, "The good in something doesn't make it right in God's sight." Marriage wasn't an invention of man. It was God's idea. Read Genesis 2:18-24. What are the implications of being united together and becoming one flesh? How difficult is it for two people to become one? Why is marriage such a big deal to God?
3. The Bible puts boundaries around sexuality. Pastor Dale talked about how the way that the early Christians lived was so different than the hyper-sexualized culture that surrounded them. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:1-12. What does this passage say to you about how to live as Christians in our culture?
