—[LET'S START]—

Last week Pastor Brad encouraged us to write out the different areas of our life and think what it would mean to follow Jesus in each of those areas. Then he suggested we allow those ideas to expand throughout the week. Share one of those areas and your thoughts.

—[LET'S TALK]—

1. Have the person with the longest hair read aloud Luke 18:18-23 to the group. This was a good man seeking to be closer to God. What was wrong with how he was trying to achieve his comeback?
2. Have the person with the shortest hair read aloud Luke 19:1-10 to the group. If someone remembers the children's song about Zaccheaus, please sing (or say) it for the group. What was different about Zaccheaus and his posture towards Jesus compared to the example in Luke 18? What was amazing about his restitution to those he had cheated? His response to those in need?
3. Is there anyone in the group who was baptized as an infant? What did that mean to the family and to the individual? What is the meaning of being baptized as an adult? Explain the symbolism of baptism.
4. If God's idea of a good comeback is that we allow Him to change us, what is He changing us into?
