Message: *Courage to Move Into
the Future Part 2*

—[LET'S START]—

Last week you were encouraged to pray with the eyes of Jesus for the world around you, the heart of Jesus for those who need him, and to be the hands of Jesus to make a difference, how has that impacted you and those around you?

—[LET'S TALK]—

1. Have the person with the shortest hair read Joshua 1:6-7 aloud to the group. The big dream, the Promised Land, lay before Joshua and the people of Israel. Now they needed the courage to pursue it. Who can you encourage to pursue God's leading? How?
2. Take a close look at Joshua 1:13-16. What is the significance of the loyalty and promise of combined effort that included even those Israelites who were not going to live in the Promised Land? How does that apply to us as a part of Wooddale Church?
3. What is the difference between power and strength? In what way have you witnessed God at work around you? In what way have you seen the endurance of strength carry someone through a challenge or bring a person back from a setback on to success?
4. Pastor Dale shared about a desire to press further into imparting the hope of Vision 22 and spoke of his heart for Wooddale to **"be an epicenter of irresistible hope"** (1 John 4:17). He also commented on several of the hope initiatives that are starting or have started at our various campuses. Which one most interested you or surprised you? Take a moment to pray as a group for those initiatives.
