Teach Us to Pray Session 3 Leader's Guide

God has uniquely shaped the prayer life of every believer. In this session, we'll learn the acronym SHAPE, which is adapted from a concept developed at Saddleback Church. It stands for:

Spiritual Gifts Heart passions Assignment(s) Personality Experiences

Knowing how God made you to pray with purpose makes prayer enjoyable and effective. And we see others grow in prayer when we help them discover their shape too.

In the first group discussion time, we'll talk about heart passions. We tend to pray for what we're passionate about and also gain a heart for what we pray into. Expect to see people come alive as they share!

The second discussion is about key life experiences and people who most impacted our prayer life. This is a time to go deeper in understanding each other and seeing God at work. You'll want to be affirming and encouraging about what people share.

Personality Profile
